# Capital Campaign Update

Capital Campaign Theme: Prepare for Providence Baptist Church Transition

As Providence is leasing our current sanctuary <u>and</u> is land-locked, we **MUST MOVE** so that we will no longer be limited in the ministry of Jesus Christ that extends beyond our church doors! After asking church members to volunteer, a Capital Campaign Committee (CCC) was formed in September, 2023 to lead Providence's efforts in raising \$3.2 million to construct a new sanctuary on the land we own at 2064 West Mountain Street in Kernersville 1) from within the congregation through giving above and beyond normal tithes and offerings and 2) from outside the church.

Evangelist Delane Johnson is the Capital Campaign Committee Chairperson. Ether Joe serves as Vice Chair.

Deborah Cunningham is the CCC Secretary. Building Committee member Lue Campbell
and Trustee Trey Gallant round out the CCC. The CCC reports to the Pastor and Administrative Board.

After weekly meetings the CCC initiated the following preparation activities:

#### CORPORATE PRAYER

church's prayer conference line.
The Corporate Prayer in seeking
God's wisdom, our spiritual
growth and unity and His
provision of resources is now
conducted during Sunday
morning worship service.

### **FASTING**

A weekly 24-hour corporate fast was held from February 14 through March 28. A Fasting Brochure outlining key reasons to fast and pray was provided with 3 types of fast: all church liquidonly fast, the Daniel (21) day fast, and the normal 40-day fast. MEMBERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO CONTINUE FASTING to seek God's wisdom.

#### **PLEDGES**



#### YOUR QUESTIONS - OUR ANSWERS

Why do I need to submit my pledge now? Prior to starting construction, Providence has to demonstrate that we have enough pledges and cash before approaching financial institutions.

After submitting my pledge when should I make my donation(s)? NOW based upon your selected pledge option: monthly, quarterly, bi-annual. You may donate via check(s) made payable to Providence Baptist Church (write Building Fund on memo line of your check(s) or via electronic transfer (Givelify, PayPal, or Shelby System) accessed at providencebcknc.org by selecting the "Give" tab.

What's next? The Capital Campaign Committee focusing on best methods/ways to prepare for the public fundraising phase of the campaign through public outreach (marketing, advertising, social media, etc.).

What can I do to help? You can 1) PRAY without ceasing for God's direction and wisdom; 2) ASK if your employer will match your donation 3) USE the donation request letter to ask your family and friends to support our capital campaign, 4) PROVIDE your fundraising ideas to any member of the Capital Campaign Committee and ASK how can you assist in fundraising.
